Nationwide, over 38 million people have diabetes, and every 26 seconds, someone new is diagnosed. Approximately 870,500 adults in Virginia, or 11.3% of the adult population, have diagnosed diabetes. Every year, an estimated 52,000 adults in Virginia are diagnosed with diabetes.

Tour de Cure is an opportunity for individuals, corporations, and organizations to come together to help the ADA increase awareness, provide vital programs, fund lifesaving research, and work toward a cure.

"Every day, we continue to search for a cure and better methods of care until that cure is found. We also protect the rights of those with diabetes and offer no- and low-cost programming to help people with diabetes thrive," said Deanie Eldridge, the ADA's executive director in the Mid-Atlantic market.
