Federal programs across the NIH and CDC are essential to Virginia's fight against diabetes. Cuts threaten the research, prevention, and infrastructure supporting the 870,500 adults in Virginia living with diabetes.1

National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive & Kidney Diseases NIDDK | National Institute of Pieze Current Funding: \$12.4M

• The NIDDK currently funds 27 projects across Virginia, with \$5.6M committed to diabetes-related research in 2024 alone.



- The NIDDK supports 15 active clinical trials in the state.³
- Cuts would threaten this nationwide research engine that advances care and improves health outcomes for over 800,000 Virginians.

CDC Division of Nutrition, Physical Activity, and Obesity FY 2024 Funding: \$572,178

- Cuts would threaten over \$550,000 in direct funding to the Virginia Rural Association for Racial and Ethnic Approaches to Community Health (REACH) programs.
- Furthermore, DNPAO supports essential tools and programs used across the state. Cooperative agreements power statewide efforts to strengthen obesity prevention, enhance early childhood nutrition, expand provider training, and promote healthy communities.

CDC National Diabetes Prevention Program

FY 2023 Funding: \$2.5M ⁶

 National DPP supports diabetes prevention programs for nearly 16,500 enrollees offered by 33 organizations across 15 cities.^{7,8}

 Cuts would disrupt access to evidence-based lifestyle interventions shown to reduce the risk of type 2 diabetes by 58% in adults and 71% among seniors.

Current Funding: \$4.6M
